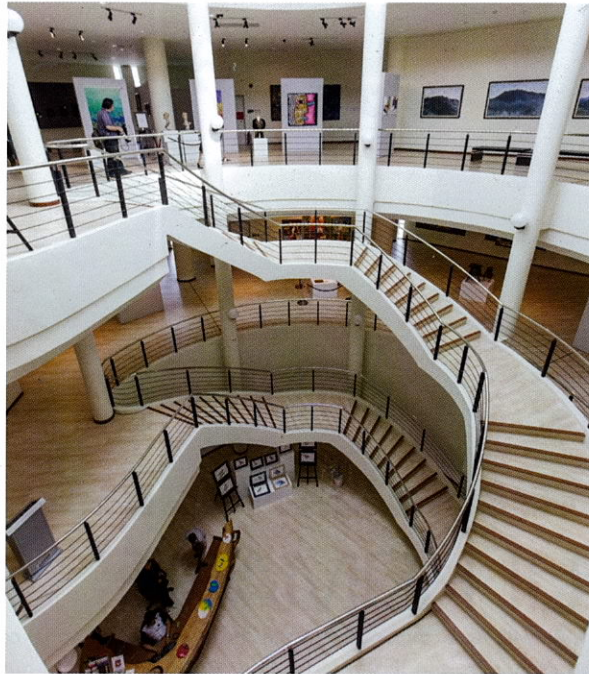


NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

REWARDING THE JOURNEY

A Journey Through Time VII, one of Asia's most extravagant watch and jewellery showcases, was another lavish affair this year. Closing the velvet curtain to the eight-day event was the *Starhill Gallery Watch and Jewellery of the Year Awards* honouring the best in luxury.

The *Favourite Ladies Watch Award* went to Jaeger-LeCoultre for their Reverso Cordonnet Duetto while Maitres du Temps took home the *Favourite Men's Watch Award* for Chapter Three Reveal. One of the more interesting awards of the year, *The Starhill Gallery Watch with Complications in Movement Award* went to Hublot's Masterpiece MP-05 LaFerrari. As for jewellery, the *Starhill Gallery Timeless Jewellery Award* went to the Sophia Loren necklace by Italian jeweller Damiani and *The Tourism Malaysia Most Revered Award* was given to Mouawad for the most talked-about necklace at the show, the L'Incomparable.
