


MOUAWAD EINCOMPARABLE DIAMOND NECKLACE

If it was not for a little girl from the Democratic Republic of Congo who went sifting through a rubble pile of kimberlite, the *L'Incomparable* diamond would probably not have been discovered. In its rough state, the historic diamond eventually made its way into the hands of renowned diamond expert Marvin Samuels, who spent four years supervising the cutting of the stone into its present form. After being displayed at several museums, the world's largest internally flawless diamond finally found its home at Mouawad and was set in what is known today as the 637-carat *Mouawad L'Incomparable* diamond necklace. It has been proudly recognised by the Guinness World Records as the most valuable necklace in the world.

Entirely designed and crafted by Mouawad's skilled artisans, the necklace was created with a total of 91 diamonds. Taking the spotlight is the modified shield step-cut IF natural fancy yellow diamond totalling 407.48 carats. It gracefully suspends from 229.52 carats of cascading and strikingly white diamonds in different cuts that are interlaced in 18k rose gold branchlets. These elaborate details complement the rare and magnificently faceted yellow diamond and completes the necklace as a significant work of art. The *Mouawad L'Incomparable* diamond necklace is fit for any lady who wishes to partake in royal fashion.
